Students wishing to apply for the Morningside University Agricultural/Rural Leadership Grant will submit a 1-page essay describing their involvement in leadership activities related to agriculture or other rural endeavors (e.g. FFA, 4-H, MANRRS, Farm Bureau, PAS, etc.) and how their experience(s) relate positively to their future. Students who earn the grant should include the following:

Leadership Submission

- Involvement in agricultural/rural leadership organizations or activities
- Leadership roles completed
- Explain one leadership experience and what was learned
- Future goals for leadership development in the university experience

- Declare a major in Applied Agricultural and Food Studies or Agricultural Teacher Education
- Join at least one agricultural student organization
- Participate in at least one agricultural student club activity per semester
- Attend at least one agriculturally-related seminar or event annually (lectures, career fair, etc.)
